The metal plates, which are the size of a license plate, are red with lot numbers marked in white. The fire department recommends that owners place them on their lots so that emergency personnel can find their home quickly in an emergency. Siuslaw Fire and Rescue says that the plates should be located close to your driveway and as close to the road as practical.
