Happy 40th To Our Greentrees Village HOA!

It's hard to believe that our village's Home

Owners Association is celebrating its 40th birthday this month! But it's true.

Back in August of 1980 property owners at Greentrees formed the HOA. Even though Greentrees lots sold out in 1973, it took seven more years before the residents made the final purchase of the "common area" (the pools, clubhouse, roads, and other infrastructure) from a group of 14 GTV property owners who had taken the option to purchase those pieces of the village from Century Park, Inc., the developer, years earlier.

At that time Century Park was a subsidiary of Bohemia Company in Eugene and Coast Real Estate here in Florence. The cost of

the final property buyout to open the door for incorporation, was \$1,000 per lot for a total of \$475,000, according to a story in the August 2010 issue of the *Village Voice*.

"When the (often contentious) purchase was completed," said the article, "the owners incorporated, formed an [HOA] association, and changed the name from Greentrees Village Mobile Resort to Greentrees Village, Inc."

GTV's HOA remains vibrant and healthy four decades later. We should note that of those early "pioneers" who were the first to purchase property here in Greentrees, and in one way or another, helped in forming our HOA, seven still reside or own property here according to the most recent office records:

John Skoog (#107); Lorraine Brinkley (#207); Kathy Mapel (#502); Charlene Mazarovich (#547); David & Rose Bittel (#548); Kimberly Cortez (#605); and Terry & Rosalie Koon (#645).





HOA FEES ON THE RISE





Florence had a population of 3,100, and lots in "Greentrees Village Mobile Resort" were priced from \$5,900 to \$7,900.

HERB-CRUSTED RED SNAPPER

Fresh from-the-sea red snapper is a treat for anyone who loves seafood. Snapper is a low-calorie, high-protein fish that contains all nine essential amino acids, and it's packed with Vitamins D and E, magnesium, selenium, and omega-3 fatty acids. This easy recipe makes it even more delectable.

- Red Snapper fillets
- 1/2 C extra virgin olive oil
- 2 slices thick-cut bacon
- 2 tsp chopped fresh basil
- 2 tsp fresh chopped chives
- 2 tsp chopped parsley
- 1/2 loaf French bread, cubed

Cook and drain bacon. Mix bread, bacon with the fresh basil, chives and

parsley leaves in food processor until finely chopped and crumbly.

Pour EVO into a shallow bowl. Pat fillets dry, dredge in the oil, then thickly coat top, or all sides, in the breading mixture. Your choice.

Arrange coated fillets in suitable baking dish. Bake at 400 degrees for 15 minutes--or until the red snapper fillets flake easily with a fork. Pair with an Oregon Pinot Noir if you are a wine connoisseur.

Subsittue halibut, salmon, or ling cod if you wish. Enjoy!

the time it takes to lead a community of this size is commemorated on the library wall by the entrance to the office.


