How Pet Owners Can Prepare For a Disaster

Most of us own pets that we cherish like our own family. If there is a major disaster such as an earthquake or tsunami we are going to be faced with some major decisions to make as to how to care for these animals. If we have a local earthquake and tsunami and you live on the west side of Rhododendron, you likely will be forced to evacuate rapidly. I know you will want to take your pets with you, but this poses a big problem. Most evacuation shelters will not allow pets and we are no exception. Our facilities will be very crowded and pets will not be allowed inside where there is food preparation and high densities of evacuees.

Many of our homes on both sides of Greentrees will hopefully survive an earthquake so that many of us will be able to return to our homes to live under very difficult conditions (no heat, no water, no food, and no electricity for some time). I would suggest that you make arrangements now with friends or other pet owners to house your pets outside the tsunami hazard zone. This implies that you will have necessary leashes or pet carriers ready to go at all times. Also, do not forget to put together a go-kit with food and water for your pets as well.

We have been having some interesting conversations at the board meetings recently.

A new concern is that some owners in GTV may have more than one residence per lot. That is to say, some people have brought in a travel trailer and have family members living in it.

I just want to get the word out there that our CC&R's do not allow more than one residence per lot. That means you cannot have two different buildings that people are living in on one lot. Nor can you have an occupied home and someone living permanently in a travel trailer. City ordinances only permit someone to live in a travel trailer, fifth wheel or RV in a driveway for (up to) 30 days. Longer than that is a violation of the single family residence clause in our CC&R's and of City code.

If you have a neighbor that has someone besides the resident living in a RV, travel trailer or fifth wheel on their property, please let the office know and we will take steps to resolve the situation.




