

Architectural Committee Clarifies Confusion About Greenbelts

Both newer people to Greentrees, as well as some of those who have lived here a while are often confused about the expectation of Greenbelts. The original purpose for the Greenbelt continues today. It is designed to give each owner privacy. From the beginning of Greentrees Village, expectations were laid out.

Each property owner should have a 5-foot Greenbelt for you and your neighbor's benefit. If you have neighbors on each side and in the back, you need a 5-foot Greenbelt around all sides. Between you and your neighbor, there would be 10 feet. That's where the fun starts!

You can clean out any or all of your Greenbelt, as long as you plant shrubs, plants, or hedges back in that area. These belts do not need to be a solid hedge. For fire safety you should have a 2 1/2-foot clear path around your outer building(s).

That means a 5-foot Greenbelt, then a 2 1/2-foot clear path next to your building.

To make any changes to the property, like adding dog runs or exterior buildings or additions, you will need to get a variance from Greentrees.

An application can be found in the office. You can also learn more about Greenbelts by reading the Rules and Regulations in your Greentrees packet. 



SMOKE DETECTOR RECALL- Kidde Smoke Detectors Recalls TruSense Smoke and Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Alarms due to a potential safety risk. The recalled units are Kidde Model Series 2040, 2050, 2060 and 2070 Smoke and Combination Smoke/Carbon Monoxide alarms purchased May 2019 through September 2020,. Only alarms with the "TruSense" logo or "AMBER=FAULT" printed on the front of the alarm are included in this recall. The model number is printed on the back of the alarm. If you have one of these models, you should immediately contact Kidde for a free replacement alarm. Consumers should keep using the recalled alarms until they install replacement alarms.
