Family Pool Opens

The Greentrees' Family pool will open on June 15th. Family pool hours are from 8:00 AM - 7:30 PM. Children younger than eighteen years of age may only use the Family pool. Those under the age of fourteen must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

As a reminder, guests who are not staying in Greentrees Village are limited to six visits a year to the Adult pool, spa or Family pool. All guests must carry guest tags. The pools and spa are closed the second Wednesday of each month for cleaning.

Greentrees Flea Market in July

The annual Greentrees Village Flea Market and Bake Sale is scheduled for July 15th. Residents can rent 8ft tables to display items they wish to sell. The public is invited to attend and the Greentrees gates will be opened for the event. The table rentals raise funds for a variety of Greentrees activities.

Tables will rent for \$10 for residents and \$20 for non-residents. A limit of two tables per person will ensure there are plenty of tables for everyone who wants to take part in this activity. Residents are given the first opportunity to reserve a table beginning on June 15th in the GTV office.

The Activity Committee is looking for volunteers to bake and contribute items for the Bake Sale. There is a sign-up sheet in the Greentrees Library for baked goods contributions. Some months ago I applied for, and was selected to participate in the South Willamette Honor Flight. The Honor Flight is conducted by non-profit organizations dedicated to transporting as many United States military veterans as possible to Washington D.C. to see the memorials of the respective war(s) they fought in. There is no cost to the veteran. Currently these organizations are focused on bringing veterans of World War II and Korea to view the memorials. Because of our age, each veteran is assigned a guardian who helps them on the flight and around Washington D.C.

There were thirty-six veterans selected for the May 11th Honor Flight. Only two veterans were from Florence - John Hyder and myself. Ironically, we both live in Greentrees Village. John's guardian was his son, John, who also lives here in Greentrees. Pictured above are the three of us after we arrived in Washington.

It was a very busy four-day trip. We boarded our plane in Portland at 6 AM on Friday and arrived at Washington Dulles at 4:30 PM. Saturday, May 13th was our tour day. We were up at 6:30, had breakfast, and were loaded on to the tour busses. We were escorted to the Washington Mall by the Park Police. There we saw the World War II, Korean and Vietnam War Memorials. We were then escorted to the Lincoln Memorial, the FDR Memorial and also the Air Force, the Navy, the Women in Military Service and the Marine Corp. Memorials. Finally, we were taken to Arlington National Cemetery and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier to witness the laying of the wreath and the changing of the guard.

It is difficult for me to express how emotional the entire trip was. At every airport there were throngs of people to greet us, especially in Portland when we arrived home on Sunday. It was all very moving and I am very grateful to the many people who made this wonderful trip possible.

"Garden Tour, postponed?" OH NO! We had way too much rain. Our tour is being rescheduled for July 29th so we can whip our gardens into shape....




