A True Computer Story by Gary Smith

Never let your guard down. Never believe that Microsoft is calling you or that they want you to call them. Recently one of our neighbors had a message pop up on their computer screen telling them that Microsoft had detected problems with the computer and “Do not turn off your computer and immediately call 800 xxx-xxxx.”

Our neighbor was scared by the message and did as was instructed. They called the number and gave out a credit card number to pay for “the fix.” Unfortunately the scammer wanted to fix a non-existent problem and charge \$199 to the credit card. The scammer’s goal was not just to steal this money but to set up a fake monthly scan and repair on a recurring basis.

The invoice was very professionally prepared and looked legitimate. Fortunately I was alerted to the scam and told our neighbor to immediately turn off the laptop computer and remove the battery. The credit card company was immediately called and alerted to the scammed charge. They stopped the charge before it was accepted.

It was a simple matter to remove the scammer’s program from the computer and verify that there was no problem in the first place. Never let your guard down and never give out a credit card number to a stranger without diligent verification.

You Need To Be Counted by Ken Stone

If there is a major disaster such as an earthquake and tsunami you should evacuate to the Greentrees Recreation (REC) Hall as soon as possible along with your 3-day survival kit. This is especially true for residents on the West side of Greentrees since large portions of it are in the tsunami hazard zone. Keep in mind you may only have minutes to safely evacuate before a tsunami arrives at your doorstep. Residents of the East and North sides also need to go to the REC Hall to sign-in, but there is not the urgency that exists for those living in the tsunami hazard zone. It is very important that you at least sign-in at the REC Hall so the GERT Team can account for you. You should not return to your home until a general all-clear has been sounded by the city-wide emergency alarm system.

Once there is an all-clear signal you may sign out and return to your residence providing it is habitable, or leave Greentrees. It is very important that we know you were out of immediate danger. This will save manpower when we start searching for those who did not sign in at the REC Hall. Search and Rescue is a risky process that puts other people in danger. It will also

provide critical information if relatives and friends are trying to determine if you are a survivor.

So, get your survival kit together and have it ready to go when you must act quickly.

Family Pool Opens

The Greentrees’ Family pool opened on May 25th. Family pool hours are from 8:00 AM - 7:30 PM. Non-residents must sign-in on the clipboards at the family changing rooms. Children younger than eighteen years of age may only use the Family pool. Those under the age of fourteen must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

As a reminder, guests who are not staying in Greentrees Village are limited to six visits a year to the adult pool, spa or family pool. All guests must carry guest tags. The pools and spa are closed the second Wednesday of each month for cleaning.

Bike Raffle

Owner Jeff Myers will again this year donate a three-wheeled bike to raffle off as an Activities fund raiser. The bike will be available to see on Father's Day in the clubhouse and raffle tickets will be available to purchase for \$1 each or 6 for \$5 from the Greentrees office. 




