You will soon be receiving information about your 2022 annual assessment in the mail. Copies of next years association budget will be mailed to all owners by December 5th along with a statement of your account through November 2021, with the dues for 2022 added. Due to an increase in Operating expenses and a 1% increase in the amount contributed to our Reserve Fund the monthly assessments will be going up four dollars in 2022 to \$250 from \$246 per month. The statement was November 22nd, so if you make an assessment payment late in the month, it will not show on the statement. This is the only billing you will receive from the Association for 2022. You may pay your assessment monthly, quarterly or annually, whichever is convenient for you.

Help Us Keep the Community Secure

As many of you have noticed, we have had some issues with the gates lately. First of all, thank you so much for your patience as we attempt to resolve an issue with a software update that caused many of your gate codes to be deleted from the system. While we continue to work through the issue, please stop by the office, or call, to get the contractor code to ensure you have a working code during the hours when the office is closed.

Speaking of gate codes, did you know... The are a variety of ways you can obtain access to the community (through the gate) and the clubhouse.

Transponder: This is a square device that automatically opens the gate as you approach preventing you from having to stop and roll down your window to use the keypad to gain entry. There is a \$30 deposit for each transponder, refundable on return.

Entry Badge: This is a creditcard size badge that provides access to both the gate and the club house. You must pass it

over the pad at the gate or door to gain access. There is a \$5 deposit for the card, refundable on return.

Key fob: This is a key-ring "badge" that provides access to both the gate and the club house, you must pass it over the pad at the gate or door to gain access. There is a \$6 deposit for each key fob, refundable on return.

The monthly contractor code: This free code only provides access to the gate and is intended for you, as owners or renters, to give to TRUSTED contractors or visitors. Contact the office at the first of each month for the new code.


