

# **Living with Bears**

We share our home with black bears. They eat berries, fruit, plants and may consume small mammals and insects. Bears should never be allowed access to

human food or garbage; it habituates them to people and increases the chance of conflict. Once habituated to food near homes, bears can become a threat to humans and must often be destroyed. We can prevent this!

- Do NOT put your trash out overnight
- Keep pet food indoors
- Hang bird feeders from wire at least 10' off the ground, 6+ feet from trunk; or take in at night
- Remove fruit that has fallen from trees
- Keep barbeque clean. Store inside. Do not leave any food residue or ice chests outside
- Do not approach or feed them
- Do not leave food, food packages, ice chests in vehicles Information from Oregon Dept. of Fish & Wildlife
