Association Annual Meeting Reminder

The 2015 Annual Meeting of Greentrees Owners will be held on August 1st in the Association's Recreation Hall. This year the Board of Directors will be hosting a free picnic lunch for the owners who attend.

The materials have been ordered for the locks, and installation will probably be some time in the Fall. We will keep you informed of the switch over to the new locks as the time grows nearer.

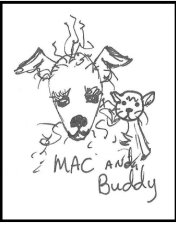
Neighbors Display Art
