Board Elections

Ballots will be mailed out October 30th for the 2015 Greentrees Village Board elections. The districts for which directors are being elected are #2, #4, #6, and #8. Two Alternates will also be elected from the Association at large. All will serve two-year terms. Even numbered district owners will be voting for a Board member and two Alternates. Odd numbered district owners will be voting only for the Alternates.

We are pleased that there is someone running for each seat, however, there is only one candidate running in each district except District 2, which has two candidates. The owners who are running are: (District 2) Mike Grenfell and Dolores Morgan, (District 4) George Lyddon, (District 6) David Johnsen, and (District 8) Pat Miller. Two candidates are running for the two Alternate Director seats: Gary Savaiano and Bruce Littlepage.

Ballots must be returned prior to November 28th in order to be counted. Board election results will be announced at the December Board meeting.
