Bobcat Sighted

A bobcat has been seen several times recently in Greentrees Village East - at 5th Street South and at 4th Street North and South. If you see the cat, keep as much distance between you and the animal as possible. Back away slowly and deliberately - avoid running away because that can trigger a pursuit response. And make as much noise as possible.

Attacks by bobcats on humans are rare, but it's always best to be cautious. They are the consummate predator, so keep your pets indoors. Deprived of natural prey, they may turn to pets for food. The bobcat is also known for it's screams at night, which often have been described as sounding like a woman screaming.
